Main Text

Hebrews 11:6-7 (ESV) – ⁶And without faith it is impossible to please him, for whoever would draw near to God must believe that he exists and that he rewards those who seek him. ⁷By faith Noah, being warned by God concerning events as yet unseen, in reverent fear constructed an ark for the saving of his household. By this he condemned the world and became an heir of the righteousness that comes by faith.

Big Idea – Daily Practice the Principle of Perspective: Live by Faith Not by Sight

Three Life Lasting Lessons of Faithfulness

Lesson #1 - The Law of Consistency: Persistent Faithfulness Brings Blessing

Hebrews 11:6 (ESV) – ⁶And without faith it is impossible to please him, for whoever would draw near to God must believe that he exists and that he rewards those who seek him.

Lesson #2 - The Law of Respect: Faithful Obedience to God Triumphs Over the Mockery of Mankind

Hebrews 11:7^a (ESV) – ^{7a}By faith Noah, being warned by God concerning events as yet unseen, in reverent fear constructed an ark for the saving of his household.

Lesson #3 – The Law of Legacy: Teach Truth, Model Morality, and Nurture the Next Generation with God’s Word

Hebrews 11:7^b (ESV) – ^{7b}By this he condemned the world and became an heir of the righteousness that comes by faith.
