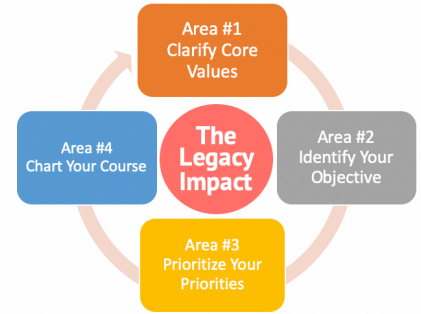
Proverbs 13:22^a - A good man leaves an inheritance to his children's children....
