Discuss Sermon

*He is no fool who gives what he cannot keep
to gain what he cannot lose. – Jim Elliot*

All of your life, you've been on a treasure hunt. You've been searching for a perfect person and a perfect place. Jesus is that person; heaven is that place. So if you're a Christian, you've already met the person and you're already heading to the place. But there's a problem. You're not yet living with that person, and you're not yet living in that place yet! You may attend church, pray, and read the Bible. But life can still be toil, can't it? You dutifully put one foot in front of the other, plodding across the hot, barren ground, longing for a joy seems hard to find some days, a treasure that eludes you. The good news is that "Joy" does not have to elude you anymore. It all begins with learning how to live out the Treasure Principle.
