1 Timothy 4:6-11

Series Summary

Series Theme Passage

Ephesians 6:13 (HCSB) – This is why you must take up the full armor of God, so that you may be able to resist in the evil day, and having prepared everything, to take your stand.

Main Passage

Big Idea – Train Up the Next Generation with the Right Tools for Victory

Three Tools to Arm the Next Generation for Victory

Tool #1 - Discipleship - Be Trained to Live Out Your Faith

1 Timothy 4:6 (ESV) – ⁶ If you put these things before the brothers, you will be a good servant of Christ Jesus, being trained in the words of the faith and of the good doctrine that you have followed.

■ **Key Point:** The first tool that we examine is discovered in verse 6 as Paul strives to equip Timothy with the right tools for victory over the enemy. He begins by reminding him of the importance of warning Christians regarding the attack of false teachers and leaders. He also reminds every Christian that in order to stand against the enemy then you must be trained to live out your faith by clearly understanding the Word of God as well as Biblical doctrine. What is this process? It is called Discipleship.

Tool #2 - Affirmation - Discover Your Identity and Values in Lord

1 Timothy 4:7-9 (ESW) – ⁷ Have nothing to do with irreverent, silly myths. Rather train yourself for godliness; ⁸ for while bodily training is of some value, godliness is of value in every way, as it holds promise for the present life and also for the life to come. ⁹ The saying is trustworthy and deserving of full acceptance. ¹⁰ For to this end we toil and strive, because we have our hope set on the living God, who is the Savior of all people, especially of those who believe. ¹¹ Command and teach these things.

■ **Key Point:** The second tool that we examine is discovered in verses 7-9 as Paul reminds Timothy of the importance of "Affirmation" in the life of a Christian. Every Christian is bombarded by the lies of the world that strives to convince them of "what they are not." This is why we must train up the current generation with the understanding of who they are" in Christ. We do this through the continual training of Godliness that happens through careful study of the Word of God.

Tool #3 - Determination - Never Stop Pursuing a Life that Pleases God

1 Timothy 4:10-11 (ESV) - ¹⁰ For to this end we toil and strive, because we have our hope set on the living God, who is the Savior of all people, especially of those who believe. ¹¹ Command and teach these things.

■ **Key Point:** The find tool that we examine is discovered in verses 10-11 as Paul teaches Timothy the importance of "Determination" as a Christian. We will face trials of many kind in this life but we must continually strive to finish faithfully because our hope is not found in the things of this world but it is set on the Living God and the eternal prize!
